Interviews for residency in specific specialty	November, December and January 2005-06 Begin in October or November for early match residencies (neurology, neurosurgery, ophthalmology, otolaryngology and urology)
NRMP rank list submitted by specialty	February 2006 (January 2005 for early match specialties)
